### Gallup, NM

#### Lexington Hotel

- 405 U.S. Route 66, Gallup, NM (505) 722-8951
- Emergency and Temporary Shelter for \*Students/ Adults/ Families.
  - Provide Assistance in seeking supportive housing.
  - \*Referrals from NTU Student Services Office SUB 214, call/drop by for an intake.

#### NOVA III

- 2915 W. Historic HWY 66, Gallup, NM 87301 (505) 297-3971
- Provides housing for Men, Woman, and Families.
  - Fee is \$20 a day, not overnight Shelter
  - Call to complete intake.

#### St. Joseph's Shelter

- 400 N. 5th St., Gallup, NM 87301 (505) 722-5156
- Accepts: Men only, must be sober enough to follow COVID precautions and ambulate safely
  - Availability: Every night except Thursday night, starting at 3 PM, doors close at 5 PM
  - Not a day shelter: Residents must leave the next morning

#### Na Nizhoozhi Center Inc, (NCI)

- 2205 E Boyd, Gallup, NM 87301 (505) 863-3869
- Men and Women for overnight shelter, does not accept children.
  - Individuals can check in after 7 PM in summer, 5 PM in winter, 7 days/week (certain medical and COVID restrictions apply)

#### Youth Shelter and Family Services

- 100 W. Hill Ave, Gallup, NM (505) 690-0491
- Monday - Friday, 8 am - 6 pm
  - Pre-screen for qualification and age.
  - Rapid rehousing program for youth ages 18-24 who are homeless or fleeing domestic violence.
  - Provide 24 months rental assessment located in Gallup/ Grants.
